Sec. 16-102. Sight triangles.

On corner lots, the erection of any fence, wall, hedge or plant over thirty (30) inches above the top of the curb which obstructs a motor vehicle operator's view shall not be permitted within the sight triangle as outlined in Chart A. These sight triangles are measured from the point of intersection of the curb returns of the intersecting streets, drives or public rights-of-way. Where no curb exists, the measurement of the sight triangles shall be made from the intersection of the edge of pavement. Where pavement does not exist, the sight triangle shall be measured from the edge of the right-of-way or property line, whichever is closer to the center of the roadway. Where there is no curb, the height of any fence, wall, hedge or plants shall be measured from the top of the existing road surface nearest to the property line.




Chart A — Sight Triangles
